Holy Days of Obligation Since 2006 Holy Days of Obligation which are Solemnities of the Lord (Epiphany, Ascension and Corpus Christi) are always transferred to the nearest Sunday. Other Holy Days (Peter and Paul, The Assumption and All Saints) are only transferred if they fall on Saturday or Monday. Therefore, Thursday 29th June is an obligation this year. Christmas Day, a Holy Day of Obligation, is always 25th December.

Peter's Pence

All members of the Church who can do so are asked to contribute to the costs incurred by the Holy See for works of Mercy and Charity and in its services to the Universal Church.

One of the boxes in the Narthex has been allocated for this purpose and will remain allocated during the month of July.
