The Parish Coordinating Committee would like to thank all who donated towards gifts for Father Tom and Canon John. At the reception following their celebration Mass Canon John was presented with theatre vouchers and wine vouchers. Fr Tom was presented with restaurant vouchers and the opportunity to tour Lords Cricket ground. Fr Tom is enjoying thinking about what further gift he would like in fulfilment of the donations received. We will let you know what this is in due course.

Young Children at Mass During the summer there will be no children's liturgy (Junior Church) and so young children will be in the church for the duration of Mass. Three years ago I produced some guidelines welcoming children and making suggestions to help to ensure that all, young and old, can enjoy a prayerful Mass. These guidelines apply to all Masses and are permanently displayed on the glass door leading from the Narthex into the main church. Copies are on the table in the Narthex for you to take if you wish. If I had to select the most important of the guidelines it would be to avoid bringing hard plastic and metal toys such as toy cars and building blocks etc. These types of toys are very disturbing and can be heard throughout the church. I look forward to your cooperation and repeat that we would like the children at Mass to be welcomed by the whole Parish family.

Peter's Pence All members of the Church who can do so are asked to contribute to the costs incurred by the Holy See for works of Mercy and Charity and in its services to the Universal Church. One of the boxes in the Narthex has been allocated for this purpose and will remain allocated during the month of July.

Eucharistic Ministers – Save the Date On Saturday 16th September 2017 all Eucharistic Ministers in the Mortlake Deanery (which includes our parish and the eight neighbouring Catholic Churches) are invited to a session led by Canon John O'Toole looking at the meaning of the Eucharist within the Catholic Church. This will provide a great opportunity to take time to reflect on what it means to be a Eucharistic Minister and to ask questions. We hope existing Ministers will join us as well as other parishioners who may be thinking about taking on this role. The session will run from 10am – 12.30pm (refreshments from 9.30am) and will be held at Our Lady Queen of Peace Church Hall, 222 Sheen Road, Richmond TW10 5AN.

First Holy Communion Programme 2017/18
Application forms are on the table in the porch. Please hand completed forms to Fr Tom. In order to make their 1st Communion next June, children must have been **born on or before August 31st 2010**, be attending Mass weekly and be in School Year 3. A detailed timetable will be given to parents as soon as possible. Children are expected to attend classes from 4.00-5.30pm each Saturday afternoon during term time from the commencement of the programme in the Autumn Term until the Communion takes place in mid-June 2018. Parents will also be expected to attend a number of meetings on Saturday afternoons. Please include an e-mail address on the form and attach a copy of your child's Baptism certificate only if he/she was baptised outside the parish.
The closing date for applications is 30th September 2017. Unfortunately, no late applications

can be accepted because the course planning requires knowledge of the size of the group.
