Easter Communion

Sunday 22nd May, Trinity Sunday, is the last day for fulfilling the precept of Easter Communion. Unless prohibited from doing so by Church law, we are required to receive Holy Communion at least once a year at Easter or thereabouts. Mortal sins (grave sins committed with full knowledge & consent) **must** be confessed before receiving Communion unless there is a grave reason for receiving Communion and no possibility of going to confession beforehand. Anyone receiving under those conditions must confess the mortal sin as soon as possible afterwards.
