Easter Communion This Sunday 22nd May, Trinity Sunday, is the last day for fulfilling the precept of Easter Communion i.e. receiving Communion at least once a year unless prohibited from doing so by Church law. Mortal sins (grave sins committed with full knowledge & consent) **must** be confessed before receiving Communion.

First Friday Community Lunch is on Friday 3rd June in the church hall, 12.30 – 2pm. A delicious light lunch of home-made soup with bread and cheese, followed by pudding, tea/coffee, at a cost of £5. A small raffle raises extra funds for the charity which this month will be Integrated Neurological Services (INS). Last month we raised £290 for Kew Community Trust. Thank you for your valued support.

Southwark Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes

The Annual Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes this Year will take place from Friday 19th – Friday 26th August, led by Archbishop Peter Smith. In this Jubilee Year of Mercy, the Diocese would like as many parishioners as possible to join the pilgrimage.

The cost will vary depending on mode of travel and choice of hotel (from £752 by air, from £687 by train).
