GENERAL PARISH NOTICES

The New Sound System has now been installed in the church and we would welcome any feedback. There is now volume control for the speakers in the Narthex. The button is up on the wall just to the right of the far left door into the church. It is positioned high so that only adults (and not small children) can move the white dial. If you are in the Narthex during Mass (for example, because of a crying child), please feel free to adjust the volume control so that you can hear the Mass clearly. **Important note for all those who clear away after Mass:** The microphone and stand MUST NOT BE MOVED and MUST REMAIN IN PLACE by the lectern. Please can parents whose children help to clear away, make sure they are aware that the microphone and stand no longer should be put away in the sacristy. Thank you.

Canon John's Induction as Parish Priest of Purley

This will take place on Monday 23rd October at 7.30pm and Canon John welcomes anyone who would like to attend. The service will probably finish at about 8.45pm and although I am not sure I expect that there will be a reception afterwards which, if you stay, means that it will be about 9.30pm before you leave. In view of the distance and the timing we need to plan the visit. If you plan to drive there you would be travelling in the rush hour. My memory is that there is not an especially large car park. The church is within easy walking

distance of Purley railway station, but it would be a rush hour journey there via Clapham Junction. We might consider a coach if there is enough interest (subject to Finance Committee approval and/or a contribution from you). I have put a list in the church for you to enter your name if you think that you might attend. Please sign ASAP so that we can think about it and if there are sufficient numbers I would be grateful for help in planning the visit.

First Holy Communion, 9:30am on 20th May 2018
The closing date for applications is TODAY.

Application forms are on the table in the porch. Please hand completed forms to Fr Tom today. In order to make their 1st Communion next May, children must have been **born on or before August 31st 2010**, be attending Mass weekly and be in School Year 3.

Monday 2nd October is too late for applications and they will not be accepted.

The Rosary in October Those who recite 5 decades of the Rosary in church, or as a family, a religious community, or as a group of the faithful, may gain a plenary indulgence daily; in other circumstances a partial indulgence. A partial indulgence may be obtained daily by reciting the Litany of Loreto and the Prayer to Saint Joseph. There are some brief notes on indulgences in the Narthex for you to take if you wish.

CAFOD Harvest Fast Day, Friday 6th October The aim is to raise money for CAFOD's work with the poor. Please take an envelope and gift aid if you can. At the 11am Mass on Sunday 8th October there will be a speaker from CAFOD who will share with us further details about how the funds we raise are helping those in need.
