**Canon John's Induction as Parish Priest of St John the Baptist Church, 48 Dale Road, Purley CR8 2EF. This will take place on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October at 7.30pm** i.e. in 7 or 8 days' time. Canon John welcomes anyone who would like to attend. The service will probably finish at about 8.45pm and although I am not sure I expect that there will be a reception afterwards which, if you stay, means that it will be about 9.30pm before you leave. If you plan to drive my memory is that there is not an especially large car park but I can ask if you would like me to or you can telephone or email them (details above). The church is within easy walking distance of Purley railway station. I will travel by train and will be leaving Kew Gardens Station at 5.39pm, arriving at the church at 10 to 7. There is a later train arriving at about 7pm, but part of the journey is on the notorious Southern Rail. If you would like to travel with me please let me know. I have put a list in the church for you to enter your name if you think that you might attend.

**The New Sound System** has now been installed in the church and we would welcome any feedback. There is now volume control for the speakers in the Narthex. The button is up on the wall just to the right of the far left door into the church. It is positioned high so that only adults (and not small children) can move the white dial. If you are in the Narthex during Mass (for example, because of a crying child), please feel free to adjust the volume control so that you can hear the Mass clearly. **Important note for all those who clear away after Mass:** The microphone and stand MUST NOT BE MOVED and MUST REMAIN IN PLACE by the lectern. Please can parents whose children help to clear away, make sure they are aware that the microphone and stand no longer should be put away in the sacristy. Thank you.

**The Rosary in October** Those who recite 5 decades of the Rosary in church, or as a family, a religious community, or as a group of the faithful, may gain a plenary indulgence daily; in other circumstances a partial indulgence. A partial indulgence may be obtained daily by reciting the Litany of Loreto and the Prayer to Saint Joseph. There are some brief notes on indulgences in the Narthex for you to take if you wish.

**Security** *In view of the incidence of terrorist attacks this year, including one in a church in France, Priests have been asked to remind you of the need for vigilance. Please let me know if you see anything or anyone suspicious and please do not leave bags unattended. Many thanks. Fr. Tom*
