Fr. Tom writes: This will be the only Mass at St. Winefride's this Sunday. There will be 6pm Mass on Saturday, 19th for those who cannot come on Sunday, though I do hope most of you will be able to attend. If you are elderly or have mobility problems and would like a lift, please phone Fr. Tom (8940 3101). Times for other local Masses are on the notice board should you need them. **I am keen to see children at this Mass.** There will be no children's liturgy but the children will be invited onto the Sanctuary for the 'Our Father'. Mass will be followed by a reception in the Hall where there will be a finger buffet with wine and soft drinks.

Church Heating We are arranging for the boiler to be replaced and we have hired a propane gas heater which we will use to warm the church before Mass. This

is far from ideal. If you are concerned that your health will be adversely affected please talk to Fr. Tom.

Weekday Masses These will be celebrated in the back room of the house until the heating problem is resolved.
