Crib Offering 2018 Your crib offerings will be donated to the Catholic Children's Society Crisis Fund which was launched in our Archdiocese in 2015. This fund provides one-off grants to support children and families who are facing a crisis in their lives. Any Parish Priest or Head teacher can apply to this fund on behalf of families and the Catholic Children's Society responds within 24 hours. Every single penny raised through your crib offering will be given out through these emergency grants to local children and families who are in dire need. Please see the poster in the Narthex.

Christmas Offering Envelopes are now available on the tables in the Narthex. As you know the collection on Christmas Day (and Easter) is traditionally your gift to the priest. For those who have Gift Aid envelopes please use them as usual and see the note below.

Gift Aid Envelopes for 23rd & 25th December Please note that there has been a printing error with the envelope sets this year. You should have a green envelope for the regular collection on Sunday 23rd December and the next envelope in your pack is yellow and is for your Christmas Day offering for the parish priest. That yellow envelope incorrectly shows the date as 23rd December, instead of 25th, Christmas Day. Any donations made using the yellow "Christmas offering" envelope will be your personal gift to Father Francis. This is the case, regardless of when you actually put the envelope into the collection plate. If, exceptionally, your set does not include a "Christmas offering" envelope, you can instead use one of the undated envelopes from the back of your envelope box set and write "Christmas offering" on it.

Sunday Evening Mass **There will be no Sunday evening Mass after Christmas** but they are available in the following local parishes for those who might need them: St Mary Magdalen, Mortlake 6.30pm and St Elizabeth of Portugal, Richmond 5.30pm.

Baptism Course There will be a Baptism Course held at St Winefride's on Saturday 19th January. Please speak to Fr Francis if you have a child who you would like to have Baptised in the New Year and if you would like to join this course.
