Holy Thursday, 13th April

No morning Mass but there will be Prayer of the Church at 9.30am.

Mass of the Lord's Supper, 8pm: I urgently need volunteers to have their feet washed as part of the Liturgy. Please sign the list on the table in the Narthex. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion should renew their commitment to their Ministry at this Mass.

We also need volunteers to watch before the Blessed Sacrament on Holy Thursday evening at various times between the end of Mass and Midnight. There is a list for you to sign up for this.

Good Friday, 14th April

No morning Mass but there will be Prayer of the Church at 9am.

A day of fasting and abstinence

Abstinence means no meat, though fish and eggs are permitted. Those 14 years and over should abstain.

Fasting means one full meal only, with a light breakfast and supper. This applies only to those between 18 and 60 years of age.

Good Friday, Children's Stations of the Cross

'*Share Jesus' final journey*' at 10am on Good Friday. This is specially prepared for the children 5-10 years old. We move from Station to Station and the children are given parts to read. Adults are also welcome.

Good Friday, Ecumenical Walk of Witness

Churches Together in Kew will be organising a Walk of Witness on Good Friday, 14th April. **Starting 12 noon at St Anne's**, going on to St Winefride's and ending at Kew Gardens station, where we will be distributing Hot Cross Buns. Please join us to remind people of the real meaning of Good Friday. More details to follow.

There will be **no Richmond Passion Play** this year.

The Papal Collection for Holy Places

which will be taken on Good Friday, is used to maintain 74 churches and shrines associated with the life of Jesus. It helps the work of the Church in the Holy Land and elsewhere by the relief of poverty and suffering. Parishes, schools, orphanages and medical centres there rely on assistance from this collection. Gift Aid donors are asked to use a spare envelope and write 'HOLY PLACES' on its front.

The Easter Vigil, 15th April 8.30pm I would urge as many of you as can to attend the vigil. Numbers are usually low because of its length (up to 2hrs) but the Church describes it as 'the greatest and most noble of all Solemnities' and of course it fulfils your Sunday obligation. Every family should attend at least once in a lifetime.
