**Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> April, DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY** Between 1931 and 1938 Sr Faustina, a Polish nun, saw visions of Our Lord. He asked that the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday after Easter (i.e. the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter) should be a Feast of Mercy, when the image of Jesus as seen by Sr Faustina would be blessed and priests would preach about God's unfathomable mercy. Pope John Paul canonised Sr Faustina on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2000 and decreed that the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter would henceforth be celebrated as Divine Mercy Sunday.
