World Communications Day, Sunday 13 May 2018

There will be a second collection to support the Catholic Communications Network (CCN). The CCN supports the work of the English and Welsh bishops and the wider church in promoting the gospel through the media on current issues. There is a World Communications Day card available in the Narthex which gives more information and Pope Francis' message to journalists. There are plenty of the cards so do please take one.

Fr Tom will be on retreat from after 11am Mass on Sunday 20th May and will return in the late afternoon on Friday 25th May. Fr Julian Shurgold will celebrate the Sunday 6pm Mass for you on 20th May. **Unfortunately there will be no weekday morning Masses from Monday 21st May – Friday 25th May inclusive.**

Easter Communion Trinity Sunday, 27th May, is the last day for fulfilling the precept of Easter Communion i.e. receiving Communion at least once a year during the Easter season unless prohibited from doing so by Church law. Anyone conscious of having committed a grave sin must receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation before going to Communion.

Holy Days of Obligation Some of you will know that some years ago the Church in this country decided to transfer Holy Days of Obligation relating to the Lord to the nearest Sunday. However, the Bishop's Conference decided that this year and from now on the Ascension would be celebrated on the Thursday after the Sixth Sunday of Easter. Hence we celebrated it last Thursday, 10th May. The next Holy Day, The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) will be transferred to the nearest Sunday and will be celebrated on Sunday 3rd June. I will try to give you advanced warning of any other changes.

New Memoria and Feast Day This Year Those who attend weekday Mass might like to note that there is a new feast day 'Our Lord Jesus Christ, The Eternal High Priest' on 24th May and an obligatory Memoria 'Blessed Virgin Mary Mother of The Church' on 21st May.

Bishops' Conference: Prayer for Peace At this time of heightened international tension the Bishops' Conference asks priests and people to pray daily for peace in the world and for greater collaboration between all nations. They would like to recommend that, in the coming months the following Daily Prayer for Peace be used at Mass:

Let us pray, through the intercession of Mary Queen of Peace, for peace on earth and an end to violence and terrorism in our world, for a new spirit of trust and collaboration between nations, for the gift of wisdom for our politicians and leaders, and especially for the resolution of long-standing conflicts in Syria, Gaza and Ukraine, and in other countries around the world.

Data Processing Regulations As you might be aware there is new legislation on the horizon regarding personal data. This is known as the General Data Protection Regulation or GDPR and is effective from 25th May 2018. These new rules mean we will be making some changes to how we hold and use personal data. At the moment we hold personal data about most of our parishioners and for many about their families as well. We will be writing to you soon about how we process your personal data and we would be grateful if you could respond quickly and help us implement these new regulations. If you don't respond we may be obliged to stop contacting you about some things. Please rest assured that whilst these new regulations may seem onerous they are designed to protect everyone's personal information. Thank you.
