**Achieving For Children** There is a letter on the noticeboard in the Narthex thanking those who bought presents from the Advent Angel Tree.

**Crib Offering 2018** This is the last week to make offerings and these will be donated to the Catholic Children's Society Crisis Fund. This fund provides one-off grants to support children and families who are facing a crisis in their lives. Any Parish Priest or Head teacher can apply to this fund on behalf of families and the Catholic Children's Society responds within 24 hours. Every single penny raised through your crib offering will be given out through these emergency grants to local children and families who are in dire need.

**Sunday Evening Mass** There is now no Sunday evening Mass here but they are available locally at St Mary Magdalen, Mortlake 6.30pm and St Elizabeth of Portugal, Richmond 5.30pm.
