Christian Unity From 18th until 25th January the Church observes 8 days of Prayer for Christian Unity. The theme this year is 'Your Right Hand, O Lord, Glorious in Power'. The theme is taken from Exodus 15:6 and points to the Glorious Power of God to draw people together in the desire for Christian Unity. Jesus prayed to His father that those given to Him by the Father would be one, just as the Father and He are one. It is important that the world sees Christians as being as united as possible, despite some of our differences.

Throughout the 8 days we will say a simple Unity Prayer at the start of each Mass. Copies will be available in the Narthex for you to take. **On Wednesday 24th January there will be a Christian Unity Service at 10am at Queen's School, Cumberland Road, Kew, to which we are all welcome.**
