First Holy Communion Programme 2018/19

Application forms are on the table in the Narthex. Please hand completed forms to Fr Tom. In order to make their First Communion next June, children must have been **born on or before 31st August 2011**, be attending Mass weekly and be entering School Year 3 in September 2018.

A detailed timetable will be given to parents as soon as possible. Children are expected to attend classes from 4.00-5.30pm each Saturday afternoon during term time from the commencement of the programme in November 2018 until the Communion takes place in June 2019. Parents will also be expected to attend a number of meetings on Saturday afternoons. Please attach a copy of your child's Baptism certificate only if he/she was baptised outside the parish.

The closing date for applications is Tuesday, 31st July 2018. Unfortunately, no late applications can be accepted because the course planning requires knowledge of the size of the group.
