**Annual Parish Census** All parishioners are kindly asked to collect a Parish Census Form from the Narthex. Forms should be completed and returned to the parish office at your earliest convenience. NB: this form is in addition to the regular 'Parishioner Form' which some of you have already completed.

**Daily Mass on Tuesdays** Beginning in Advent, on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> December, the daily Mass on Tuesdays will be said at 7pm instead of 9.30am. This will be a permanent change, offering us an evening Mass during the week. Fr Francis had previously suggested an evening Mass on Thursdays but further to consultation with parishioners this has now been changed to Tuesdays.

**Bible Study in Advent** Fr Francis will be leading a Bible Study group, with an Advent theme, after the 7pm Mass on Tuesdays during Advent. All are welcome. Once again, this Bible Study was originally suggested for Thursday evenings but will now take place on Tuesday evenings instead.

**Morning Prayer** Starting in Advent there will be Morning Prayer on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays & Fridays at 9.15am in the church, before the 9.30am Mass. This will begin on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> December.

**The Society of St Vincent de Paul (SVP)** in the parish exists to help those in need by providing companionship, transport, practical assistance and modest financial help. If you or someone you know needs help, please ask Father Francis to let us know and we will be in touch.

**The Advent Angel Tree** On the weekend of 1<sup>st</sup> December there will be a Christmas tree in the Narthex decorated with paper angels.
