Children's Liturgy Groups

Children in the infant Liturgy Group who are in Year 2 can now move up to the Junior Group. Please note that both sessions start promptly at 9.30am so if you are running late please go straight into church and do not disturb the groups. It is also essential that your child is signed in by their parent/carer, so please don't leave them by the door without doing so.

Thanks to the team who put time and care into the preparation of the sessions.

Annual Parish Mass (1) This Mass will be held next Sunday, 20th November at 10:30am. It will be the only Mass next Sunday and you are urged to come and join in this important celebration of parish worship and community.

This year we have something to celebrate with the recent approval to remove the Tree of Heaven. The removal of the tree will pave the way for us to begin the improvement of our disabled access and the enhancement of our garden (please see separate notice re a Working Party). In addition, when replacing the Church boiler we plan to install enough capacity for heating both Church & Hall which would give space to upgrade our Hall facilities.

Mass will be followed by a reception in the Hall where wine and soft drinks will be provided. As in previous years, and in the spirit of community, we ask that parishioners contribute the finger food for the reception and there are charts in the Narthex for you to sign up for the items you are able to provide. Last year you enabled a splendid reception so let's do at least as well this year!
